Modern EPC Projects have more interfaces and extensive pressure to reduce costs and commit to lump sum contracts. Work is performed in various engineering centers, with multiple vendors, and across numerous fabrication yards. Suppliers are global, regulatory oversight is increasing & Client first production schedules are shortened. Managing these multiple challenges requires concise detailing, tracking, communicating and completion of assigned project tasks, which is mandatory for a successful project.
