Teacher with support from principal will:

	earn about the specific disability of child coming to class

\Box L	ook for volunteers to help first weeks

Teacher and principal will work with parent of child with disability	
\Box A	sk parent to visit school before child begins to look at environment
	'ell parent about classroom routines and activities – ask their opinion about ow to help their child integrate
\square M	Take sure parent knows educational goals of child and how they can help
\square S	et up a system for communication between teacher and parent
	Make sure all school staff are informed about importance of creating a velcoming environment
Teacher or Principal will communicate with parents of non-delayed children	
□ T	alk to all parents about the importance of inclusion
Teacher or Principal will communicate with parents of child with disability	
\Box A	sks parent to come to school for visit
	Discuss classroom routines with parent
