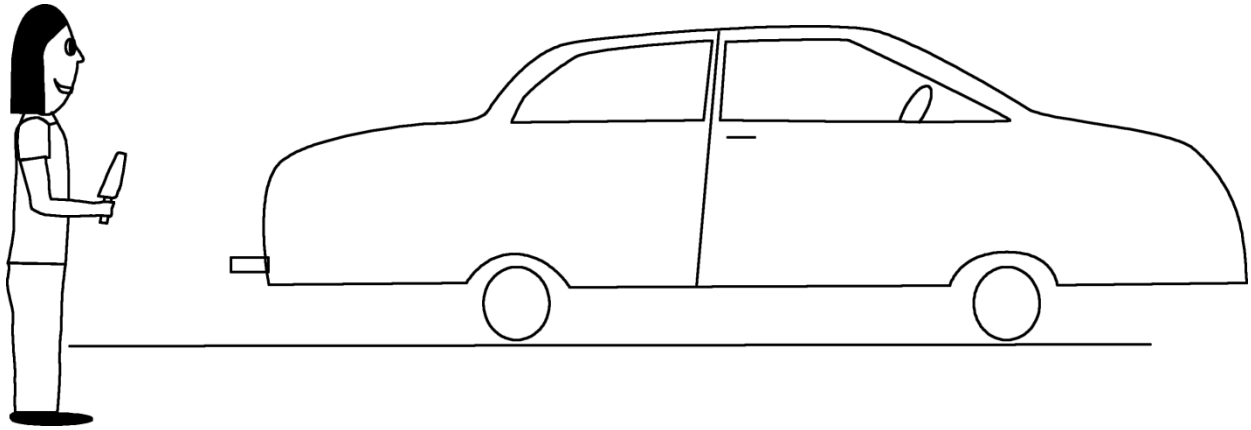
This is a bailer, and I want to bail.
Tell me, what do I bail?



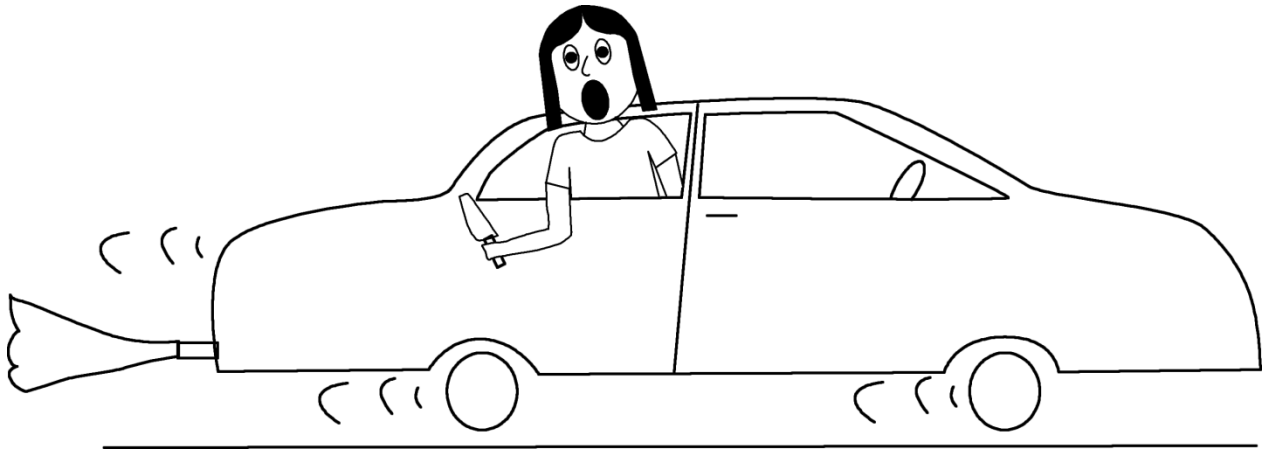
Do I bail a house?



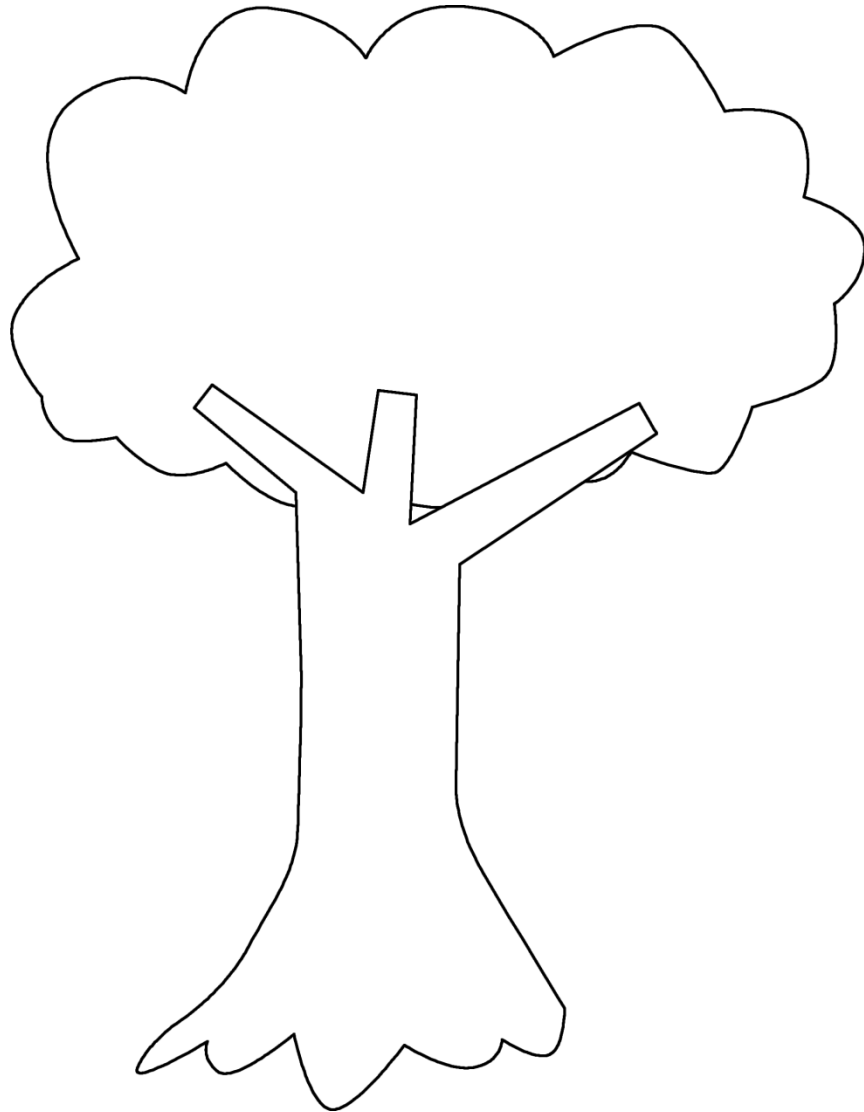
No, not if the house has doors.



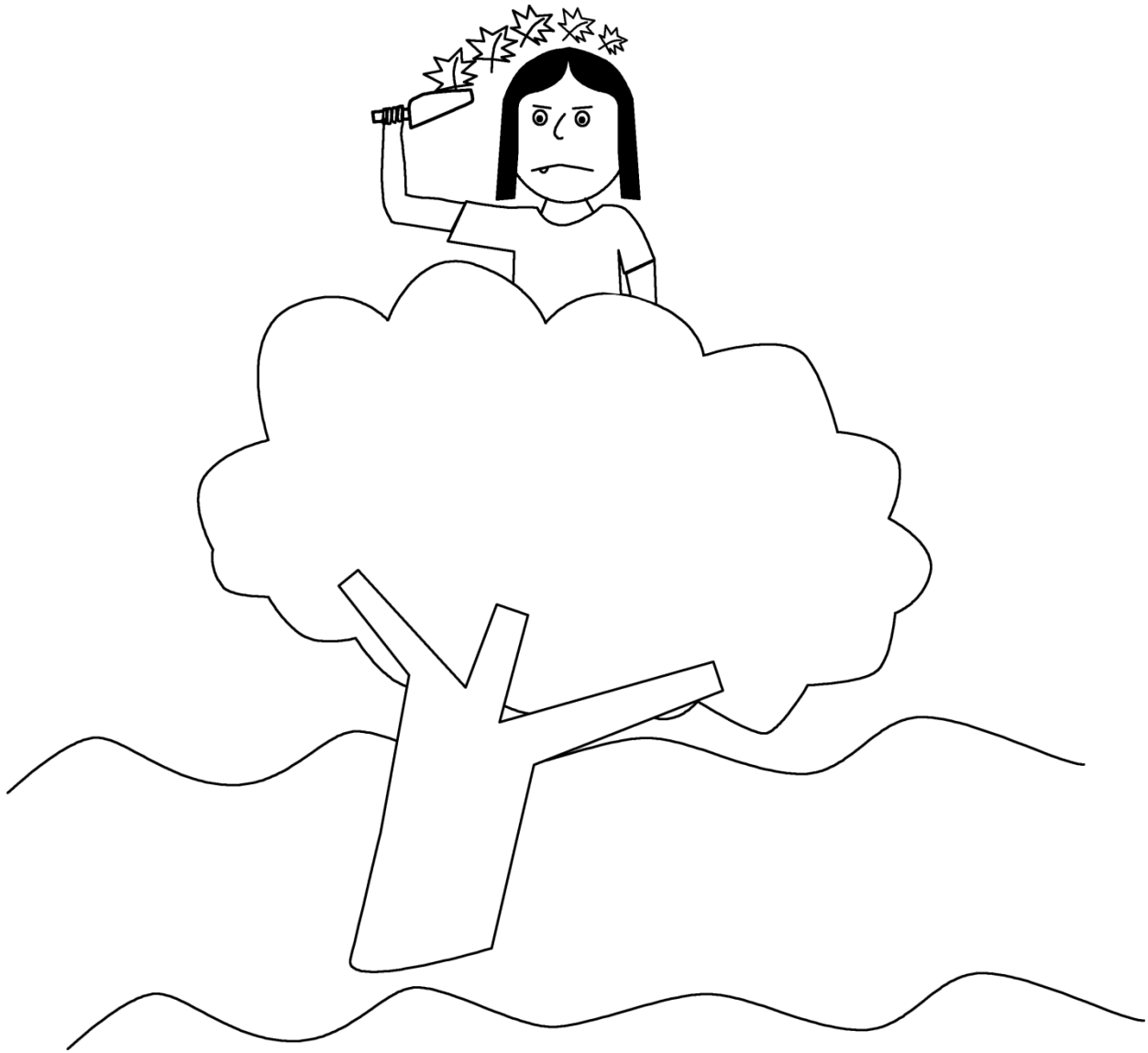
Do I bail a car?



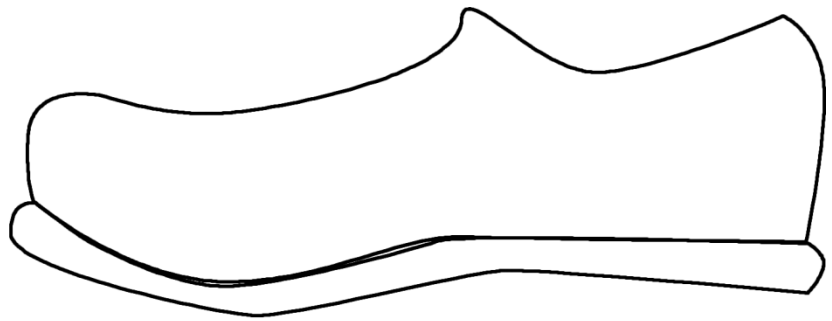
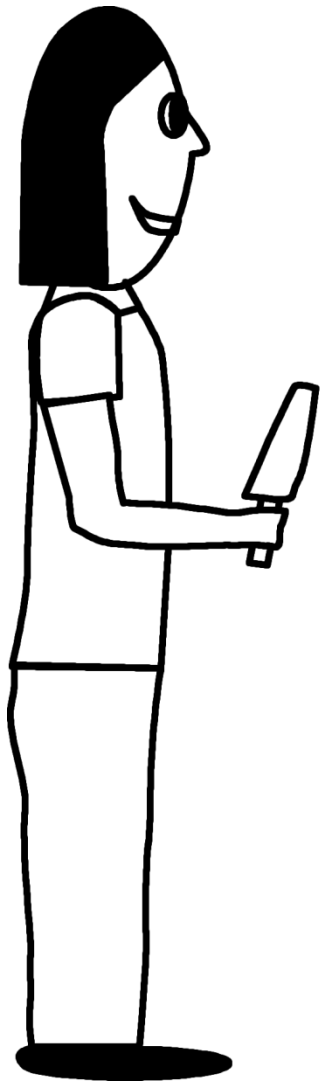
No, not if the car has wheels.



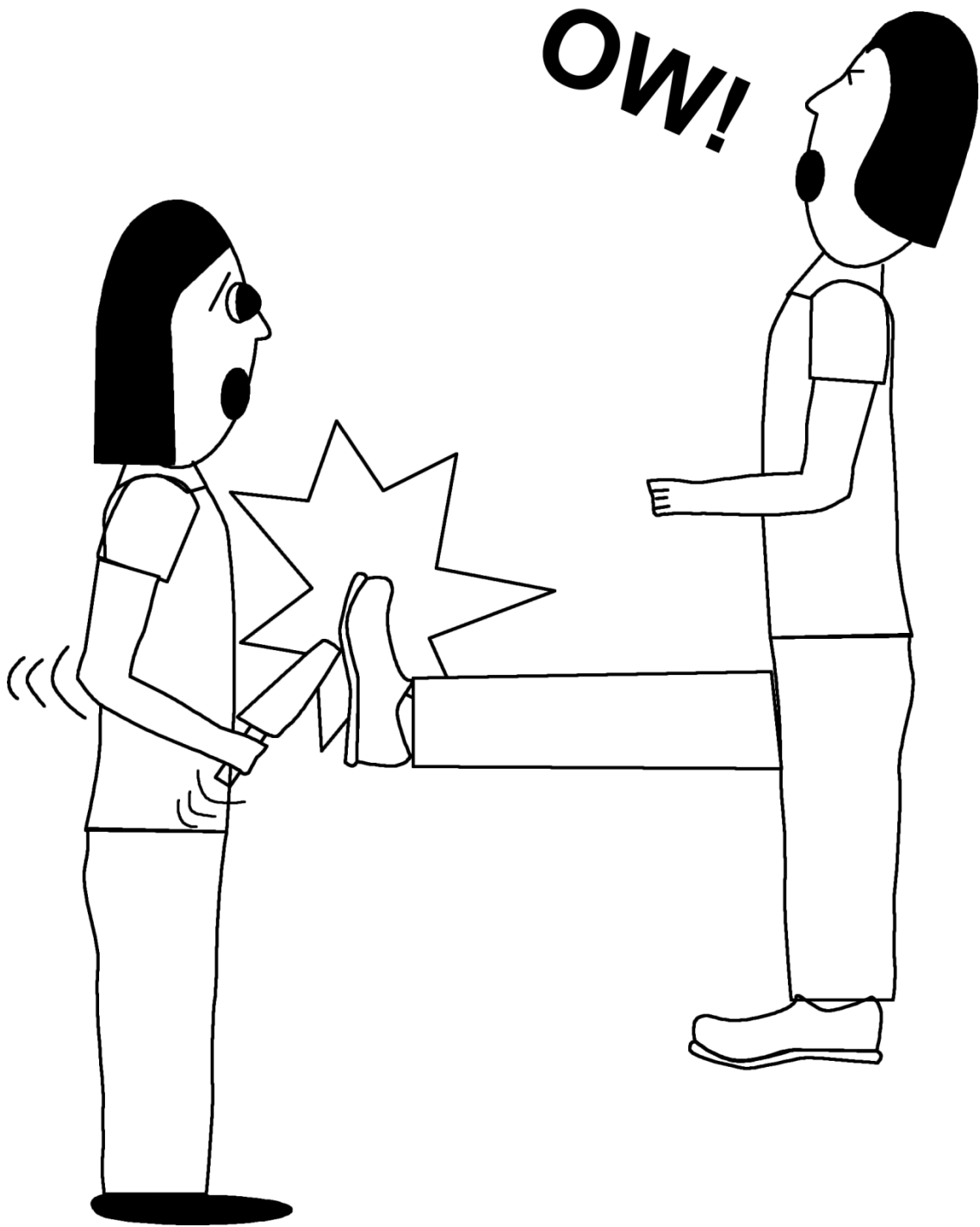
Do I bail a tree?



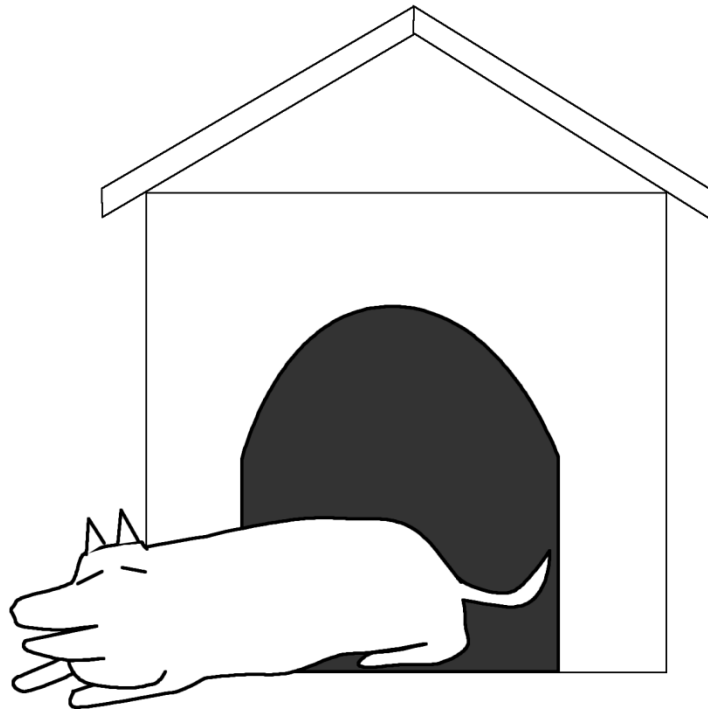
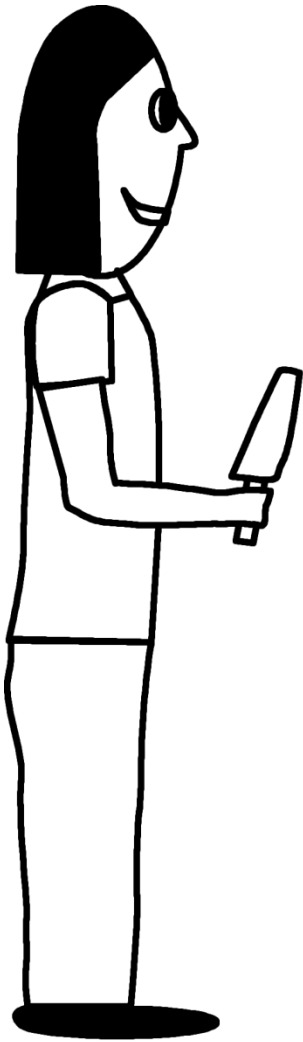
No, not if the tree has leaves.



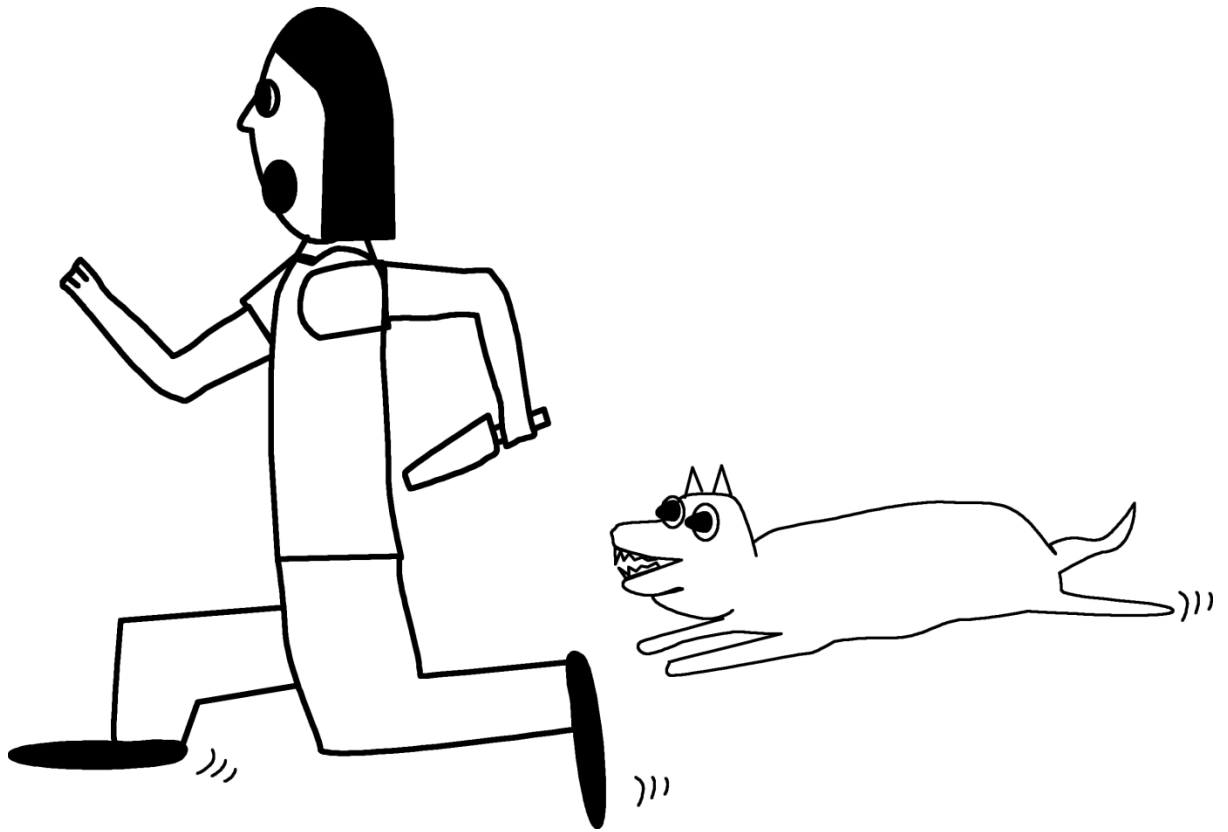
Do I bail a shoe?



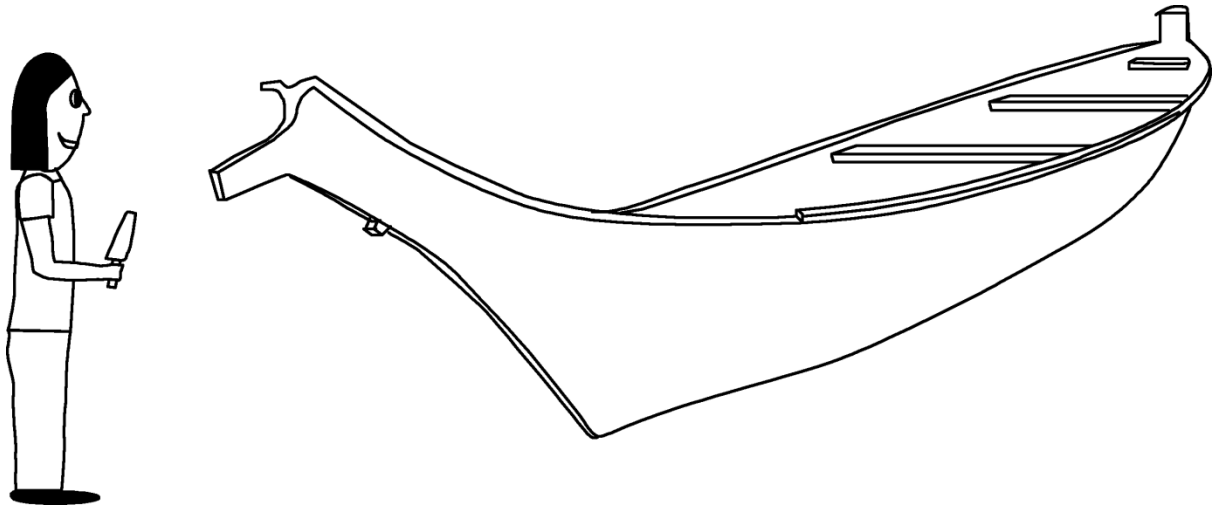
No, not if the shoe has a foot in it.



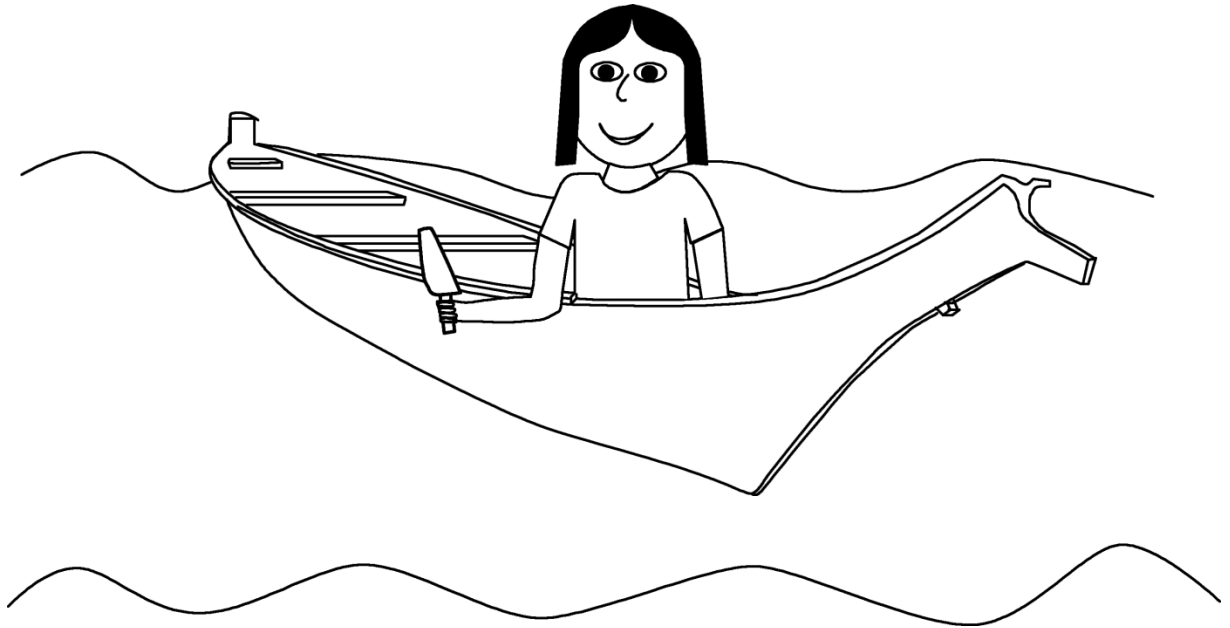
Do I bail a dog?
