The Alpha Epsilon Delta National Office membership fee is **\$75**. This one-time fee is for lifetime membership, a certificate, and a membership card. There are no annual National Office dues, but each chapter may have chapter dues.

Once inducted into Alpha Epsilon Delta, you are eligible to:

- wear the graduation regalia,
- apply for Alpha Epsilon Delta scholarships,
- attend the Alpha Epsilon Delta national convention, held biennially,
- submit articles for publication in *The Scalpel*, the journal of Alpha Epsilon Delta.
