






## The Earned Income Tax Credit has expanded criteria for 2021 that may benefit you and your family!








## There is no age cap for 2021;

 You are not required to have dependent children;







 Childless workers from age 19 to 24 (who are not half-time or full-time students) and claimed as dependents on their parents' tax return are eligible








 Qualifying children must be biological or adopted children, grandchildren, younger siblings, and nieces and nephews who live with you at least half of the year and be under age 19, be under 24 and a full time student, or be permanently disabled







## **Contact Accounting** Aid Society


- No cost tax, year-round tax preparation assistance is available for households earning less than \$58,000 a year;


