- Participants: Mercedes Quintana and Victoria Concepción Chávez.
- Discussion:
 - **Team Updates**: Ayush might not be available, and Zichen will not be advising this term. Moving forward, Victoria will be the primary advisor.
 - Project Work: They discuss issues with the app. Mercedes highlights that
 the annotations in the app are not updating correctly, as the SVG does not
