Deep Learning for the Detection and Identification of Gaseous Plumes using Hyperspectral Imagery

Abstract: We describe the integration of deep learning algorithms into a pipeline for processing hyperspectral remote sensing data. Specifically, we present how a neural network classifier can be trained to identify the chemical species of gaseous plumes present above terrain that is scanned by a remote sensor.
