Final Paper Submission Instructions

Final Paper Submission Deadline

- February 26, 2025

Authors of accepted papers should prepare the final full-length paper based on reviewer feedback and upload the final paper by the deadline.

Review of final papers will begin immediately after the deadline to prepare the final papers for submission to Elsevier. In support of the review process, authors may prepare a separate document outlining how reviewer comments will be addressed in the final paper. Please also note that to allow authors to effectively address reviewer comments, the paper length limit is now updated to 10 pages.

Accepted papers must be presented during the conference event on March 5-7, 2025. There is no required presentation template. Each paper will be given 20 minutes for presentation and Q&A.

Author Requirements:

- Paper (each) must be represented by paid registration
- Paper (each) must be presented during the conference to be included in proceedings
- Copyright will be held by Elsevier. A copyright transfer agreement will be conducted online by Elsevier after the final papers have been submitted to Elsevier.

 First Page – Fields are provided to insert paper title, authors and affiliation/address.


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- Subsequent Pages Field is provided for Author name

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- 3. **Footnote (first page only)** insert information for lead (corresponding) author only
- 4. **Page Numbers**: Do not include individual page numbers to your paper. These will be added when the proceedings volume is produced.
- 5. **Copyright Lines**: Copyright statements appear on the first page of the template (one in the abstract section and one as a footer). These are a requirement by Elsevier and may not be removed.
- 6. **Word Files**: Due to changes in Elsevier's online indexing processes, papers are now required to be submitted in doc or docx format. **PDFs will not be accepted**.
- 7. **Page Limit:** Papers must be up to ten (10) pages in length.
