Keshard is a disability advocate and a Human Resources professional with a Master of Science in Human Resources Management from Northeastern University. She was a NextGen Leader for Disability:IN for 2022 and 2023. Keshard also has co-published a chapter in a book speaking on the transition from higher education to the workforce for disability/neurodiversity relating to people of color.
