BE A MINDFUL HUSKY

DO

Keep the noise down! #1 reason police are called. Ask your neighbor to text you if you are too loud. Provide friends water, mocktails, and food. Understand Social Host Liability laws.

DONT

Drink alcohol on public sidewalks.^(§) Let a gathering get too big or unruly.^(§) Serve alcohol to underage guests or allow underage guests to consume alcohol. (§)

RASHI

BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

Introduce yourself to your neighbors. Saying hello is easy! Share contact information. Keep voices down when walking through the neighborhood.

DON'T

Ignore your neighbors. Get to know them. Be lazy. Help neighbors with packages, plants, or shoveling.

BE BALCONY & ROOF SAFE

DO {Obey all lease rules for the space. (No grills!) Ensure the space is safely lit and structurally sound.

> Go on the roof or balcony unless allowed by your landlord. (§) Exceed limitations (# of people, weight). Sit in windowsills!



Check batteries in smoke alarms and CO₂ monitors. Know your apartment fire escape routes - 2 exits! Clean gas stove burners and empty dryer lint.

> Leave cooking or candles unattended. Overload electrical outlets or power strips. Put ashes in anything but an ashtray.

BE RESPECTFUL

Show officers and city officials respect. Cooperate with the officer and follow their directions. Remember appropriate public behavior and decency.

Ignore officers. Always answer the door when they knock. Give misinformation. Do cooperate and answer truthfully. **BE GREEN & TRASH SMART**

Recycle items correctly (textiles, mattresses, etc). Check pickup schedule and proper disposal location for your street.

Consider compost options.

Put trash out too early. ^(§) Leave bins out after pickup. ^(§) Use plastic grocery bags. They rip too easily!

POLICE

NU CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT

The Code of Student Conduct applies on campus as well as off campus. Student behavior in violation of the Code, or local, state or federal laws may subject students to discipline as noted in the Code of Student Conduct. This may include a written warning, disciplinary probation, alcohol education program, fine, deferred suspension, suspension, or expulsion from the University.

BOSTON CITY FINES (\$)

When the police are called, any or all of the following can apply to you, as well as the Code of Student Conduct.

- Illegal trash disposal: Putting trash out too \$25 early or left out. Check trash and recycling pickup schedule and proper disposal location for your street.
- \$50 Disturbing the peace. 2nd offense = \$100;3rd offense = \$200. Other consequences: Court summons and possible arrest. Keep your music and noise down!
- \$200 Possessing an open container in public. Don't leave a party with a drink in hand!
- Going on the roof or balcony without **Eviction** permission in your lease = possible eviction. Your lease may include additional fines.
- Providing/buying alcohol for anyone under Summons/ 21. Other consequences: probation, court Arrest summons and/or arrest. Know the ages of your guests and limit invites.
