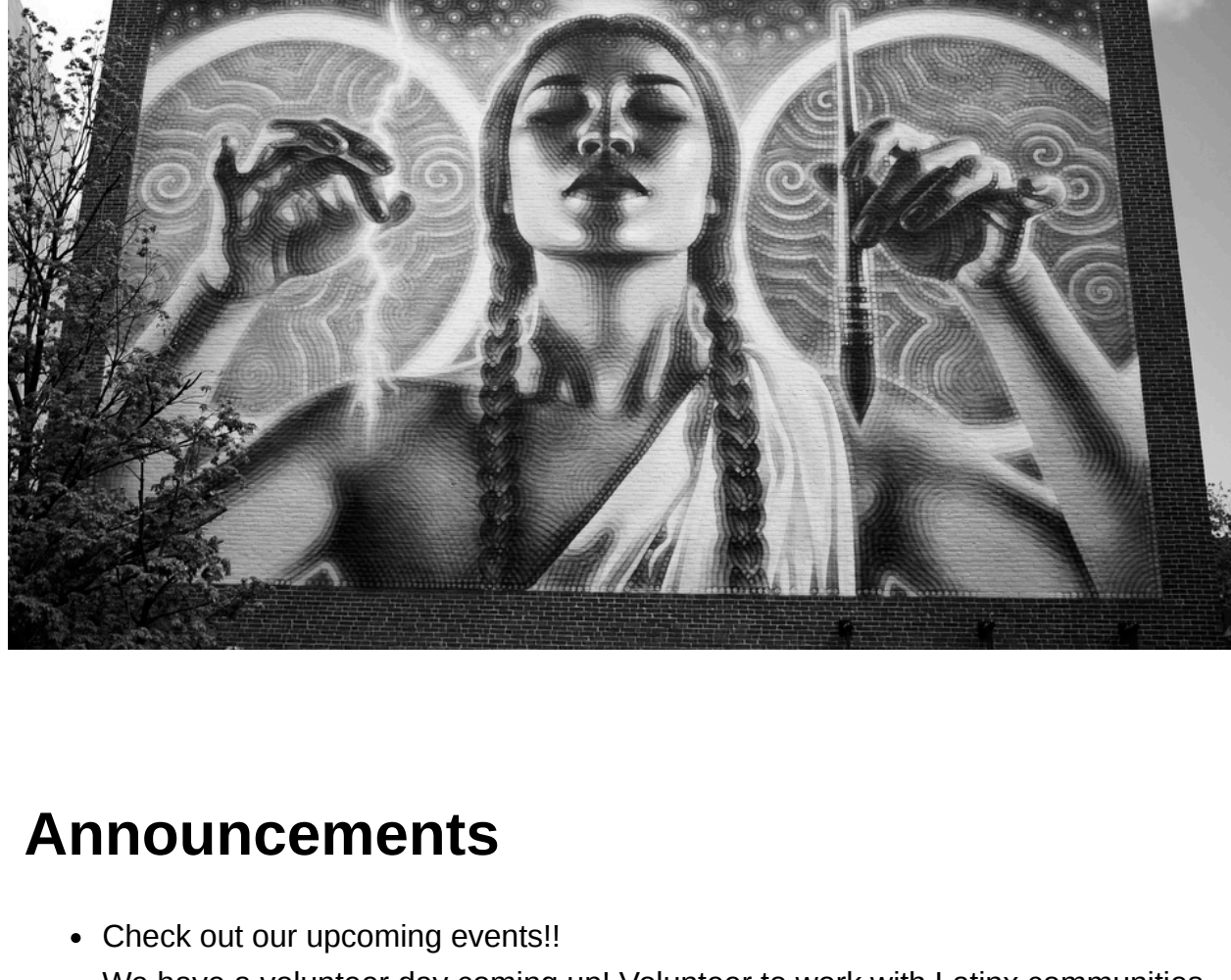

Sigma Delta Pi is hosting their annual Study Abroad Panel on **October 16th at 6:00 pm in Behrakis 220**. All are welcome to attend!

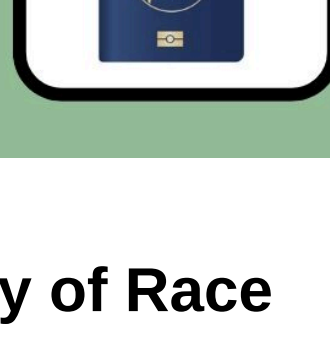

Tandem MOOC

Are you currently on co-op? Are you not enrolled in a Spanish course? Do you just need more practical speaking practice?

Tandem MOOC is a free online course offered by the **Universitat Oberta de Catalunya**. This a great way to brush up on your Spanish if you are not currently in a Spanish course.

Please note that this course does not count for college credit.

What is Tandem MOOC?

If you're a speaker of Spanish and you're learning English, or you're a speaker of English and you're learning Spanish, you've come to the right place to practise speaking! Based on different studies and theories of language learning, we have prepared this 6-week course which will help you to speak more fluently and to develop communication strategies in a foreign language.
