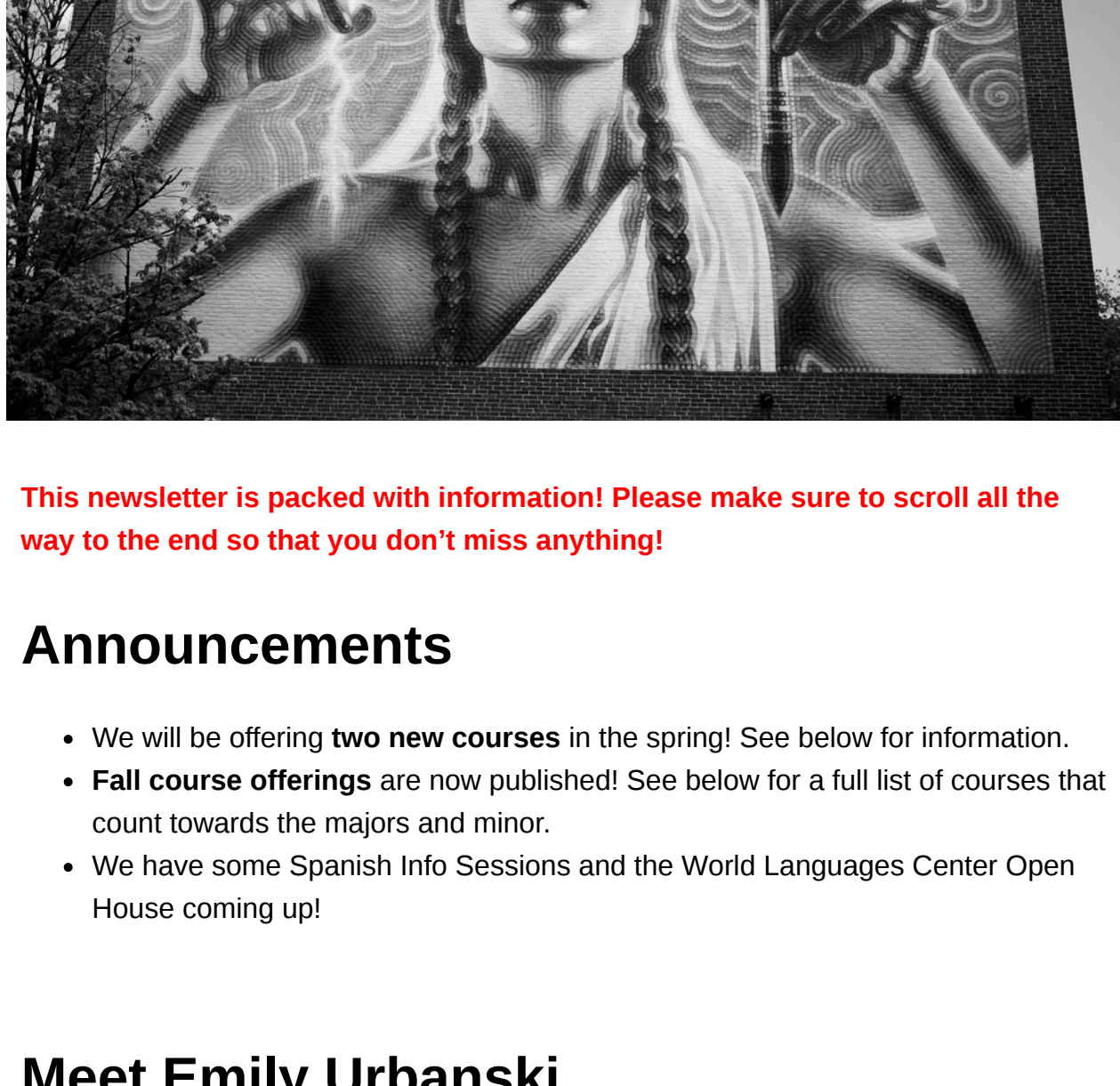

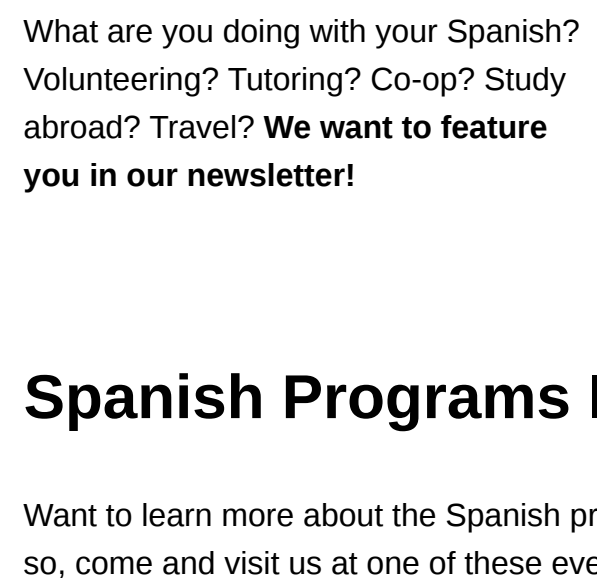

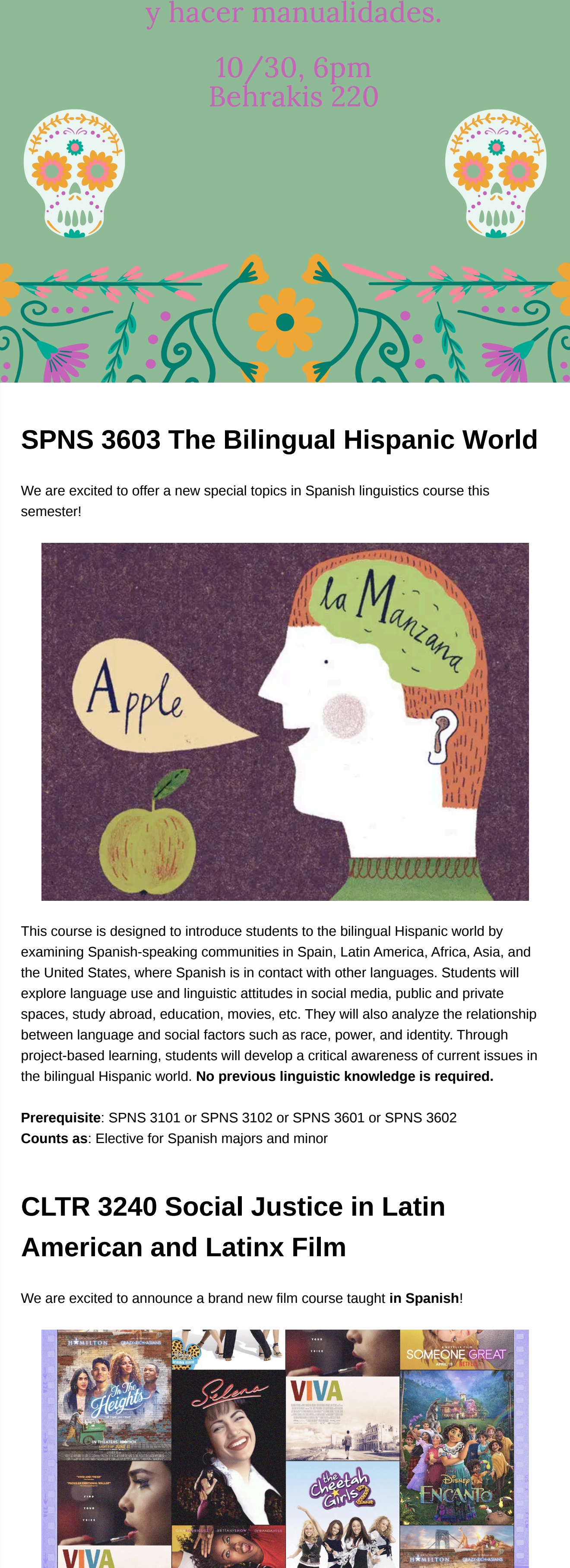

## SPNS 3603 The Bilingual Hispanic World

We are excited to offer a new special topics in Spanish linguistics course this semester!



This course is designed to introduce students to the bilingual Hispanic world by examining Spanish-speaking communities in Spain, Latin America, Africa, Asia, and the United States, where Spanish is in contact with other languages. Students will explore language use and linguistic attitudes in social media, public and private spaces, study abroad, education, movies, etc. They will also analyze the relationship between language and social factors such as race, power, and identity. Through project-based learning, students will develop a critical awareness of current issues in the bilingual Hispanic world. **No previous linguistic knowledge is required.**

**Counts as:** Elective for Spanish majors and minor
