

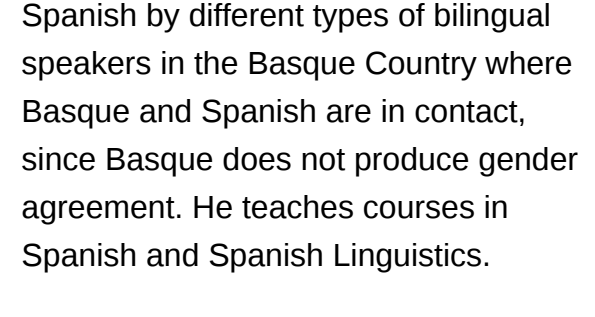

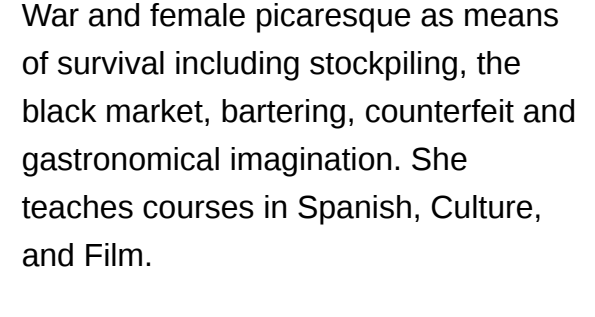
Welcome to our new professors!

Prof. Basterretxea Santiso
Assistant Teaching Professor

Prof. Basterretxea Santiso did his PhD in Hispanic Linguistics at Georgetown University. In his dissertation he explored the relation between the production of and attitudes towards gender agreement production in Spanish by different types of bilingual speakers in the Basque Country where Basque and Spanish are in contact, since Basque does not produce gender agreement. He teaches courses in Spanish and Spanish Linguistics.

Assistant Teaching Professor

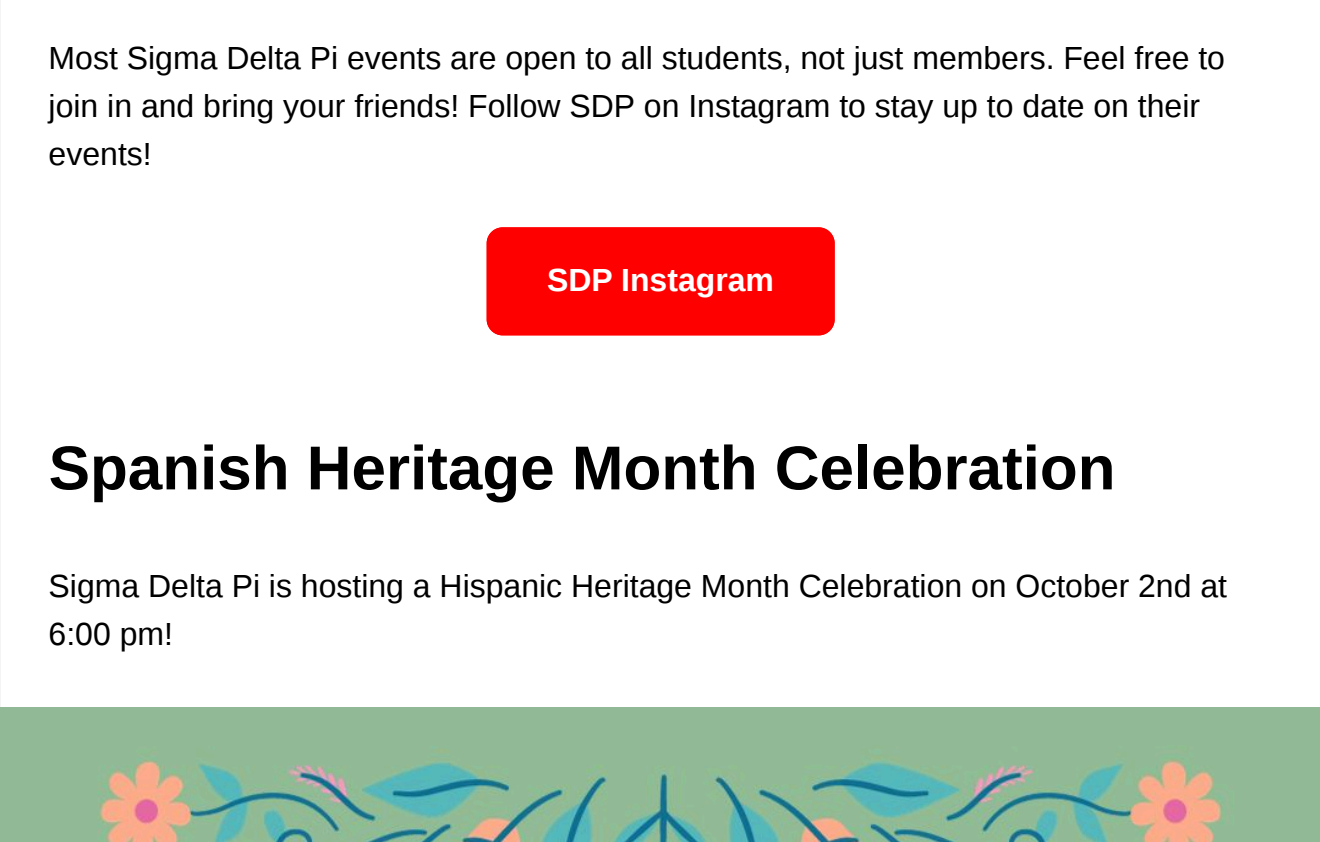
Prof. Pérez-Arroz did a PhD in Literary Studies (summa cum laude) at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid. Her research explores hunger in Spain from a cultural perspective, with a special emphasis on the Civil War and female picaresque as means of survival including stockpiling, the black market, bartering, counterfeiting and gastronomic imagination. She teaches courses in Spanish, Culture, and Film.

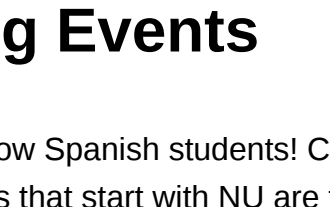
