PROFILE

Abram Lyon, according to the inscription on his headstone, was the fourth son of Simon Lyon and Lena Weil Lyon. Both of his parents were Jewish. His father was originally from northeastern France and his mother was originally from Baden-Württemberg in southwest Germany. Abram's father was a longtime resident of Bellefonte, where he worked as a butcher. Abram had eight siblings: Jacob Lyon, Maurice Lyon, Tillie Lyon, Henry Lyon, Moyer Lyon, Gustie Lyon, Minnie Lyon Oettinger, and Miriam Lyon Knight.

According to his headstone, Abram died at the age of 3 years, 2 months, and 23 days on December 11, 1877. He was buried at the Rodef Shalom Cemetery in Bellefonte, Pennsylvania. His father is also buried in the cemetery along with one of his sisters, Gustie Lyon, and his maternal grandparents, Veit Hirsh Weil and Mariam Weil.
