UNAUTHORIZED

Only half (51%) of American farmworkers in 2018 were authorized to work in the United States

HISPANIC

83% of all farmworkers were Hispanic. Among U.S.-born workers, 35% were Hispanic





BORN IN MEXICO

Nearly 7 in 10 hired farmworkers were born in Mexico

MIGRANT

19% of farmworkers lead "migrant" lives, meaning they work multiple jobs that are 75 miles or more apart, within a 12month time period



WHO LIVES IN IOWA?

POPULATION: 3,155,070



HISPANIC OR LATINO

According to the 2019 U.S. Census, 85% of Iowans are white and 6.2% are Hispanic or Latino. There are more than 150,000 Hispanic/Latino residents of Iowa.

MEXICAN POPULATION INC.

Between 1990 and 2000, the Mexican immigrant population in Iowa grew by between 500 and 600%





FOREIGN-BORN FROM LATIN AMERICA

In 2017, 37.3% of Iowa's foreign-born population was from Latin America. This amounts to 62,140 people.

HISPANIC/LATINO BUSINESS INC.

Between 1992 and 2012, the number of Hispanic-owned businesses in Iowa grew by roughly 447%



WHO LIVES IN NEBRASKA?

POPULATION: 1,934,408

Between 1990 and 2000, agricultural counties in Nebraska experienced tremendous growth: the Hispanic immigrant population grew by 1,456.5% in Lexington, NE, and by 1,377.4% in Schuyler, NE 1,457%

WHO LIVES IN INDIANA?

POPULATION: 6,732,219

According to the 2019 U.S. Census, 79% of Indianans are white and 7.1% are Hispanic or Latino. There are more than 471,000 Hispanic/Latino residents of Indiana.

In 2017, 31.9% of Indiana's foreign-born population was from Latin America. This amounts to 102,818 people.

FARM LABOR PERFORMED BY IMMIGRANTS

There are roughly 94,000 farmers in Indiana. According to the Indiana State Department of Agriculture, 7.7% of agricultural workers in Indiana are immigrants.

POPULATION: 5,639,632




HISPANIC OR LATINO

According to the 2019 U.S. Census, 80% of Minnesotans are white and 5.5% are Hispanic or Latino. There are more than 338,000 Hispanic/Latino residents of Minnesota.

Between 1990 and 2000, the Mexican immigrant population in Minnesota grew by 1,000%

FOREIGN-BORN FROM LATIN AMERICA

In 2017, 13.9% of Minnesota's foreign-born population was from Latin America. This amounts to 64,000 people.

IMMIGRANTS IN AGRICULTURE

Minnesota is home to 75,000 farms and 39,000 employed farmers. According to the National Agriculture Statistics Survey (NASS), roughly 51% of U.S. farm labor was performed by immigrants in 2014.
