


# PROGRAM AND EVENT SCREENING

This infographic provides a visual guide to help you determine when to screen program or event content, as well as individuals or organizations involved, for compliance with export control regulations and U.S. sanctions. ## Screening of Attendees Not Required


- 
- Program or event is hosted by Harvard University\* and is
    - Exclusively in-person on Harvard's campus in the U.S. OR
    - Offered online (including hybrid) or outside the U.S. and:
      - Open to the public, and
      - No registration beyond name/email address to access livestream, and
      - No registration fee or other financial transaction
  - Program or event is not hosted, sponsored, funded or organized by Harvard (alone or with others)\*

**\*NOTE:** Screening **IS** required if program content is export controlled or if the program or event is physically taking place in a country subject to comprehensive sanctions (currently Cuba; Iran; North Korea; or the Crimea, Donetsk People's Republic, or Luhansk People's Republic areas of the Ukraine)

\* Screening is required of non-Harvard hosts, sponsors, funders and organizers

## Screening REQUIRED

**DO NOT PROCEED** without screening if one or more apply:

- 
- Providing online (including hybrid) education to non-U.S. persons, other than described above in "No Screening Required"
  - Hosting, sponsoring, funding or organizing (alone or with others) a program, conference or other event abroad
  - Providing honoraria or travel reimbursements to non-U.S. persons
  - Program content is export controlled^

^Most catalog course content is not considered export controlled. However, when in doubt, contact your **School or Institute's ECA**.
