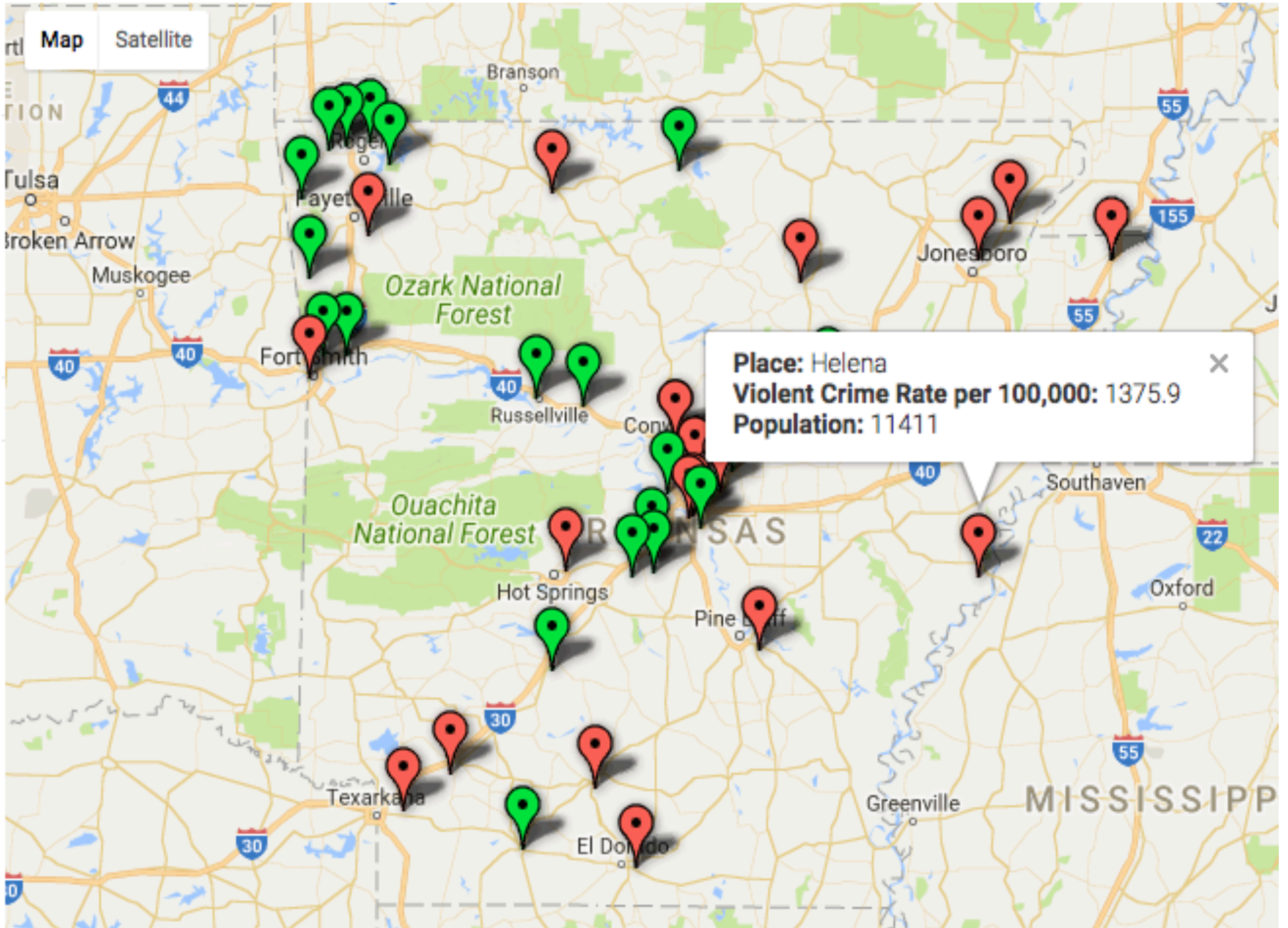

FBI on Limits of UCR Data

- Voluntary Guidelines
- Not All Locales Report
- Not all Locales Are the Same – St. Louis is City/County
- Data users should not rank locales because there are many factors that cause the nature and type of crime to vary from place to place.
- Rankings ignore the uniqueness of each locale.
- Since crime is a sociological phenomenon influenced by a variety of factors, the FBI discourages ranking the agencies and using the data as a measurement of law enforcement effectiveness.

FBI: Factors to Consider

- Population density and degree of urbanization.
- Variations in composition of the population, particularly youth concentration.
- Stability of the population with respect to residents' mobility, commuting patterns, and transient factors.
- Economic conditions, including median income, poverty level, and job availability.

Calculate a Crime Rate

Per Capita Rates Level The Playing Field

--Example: 2.5 million people & 80,000 crimes.

--Divide: $80,000 / 2.5 \text{ million} = 0.032$ crimes per person.

--Multiply 0.032 rate x 1,000 and you get:

32 crimes per 1,000 people

(fusiontables.google.com)

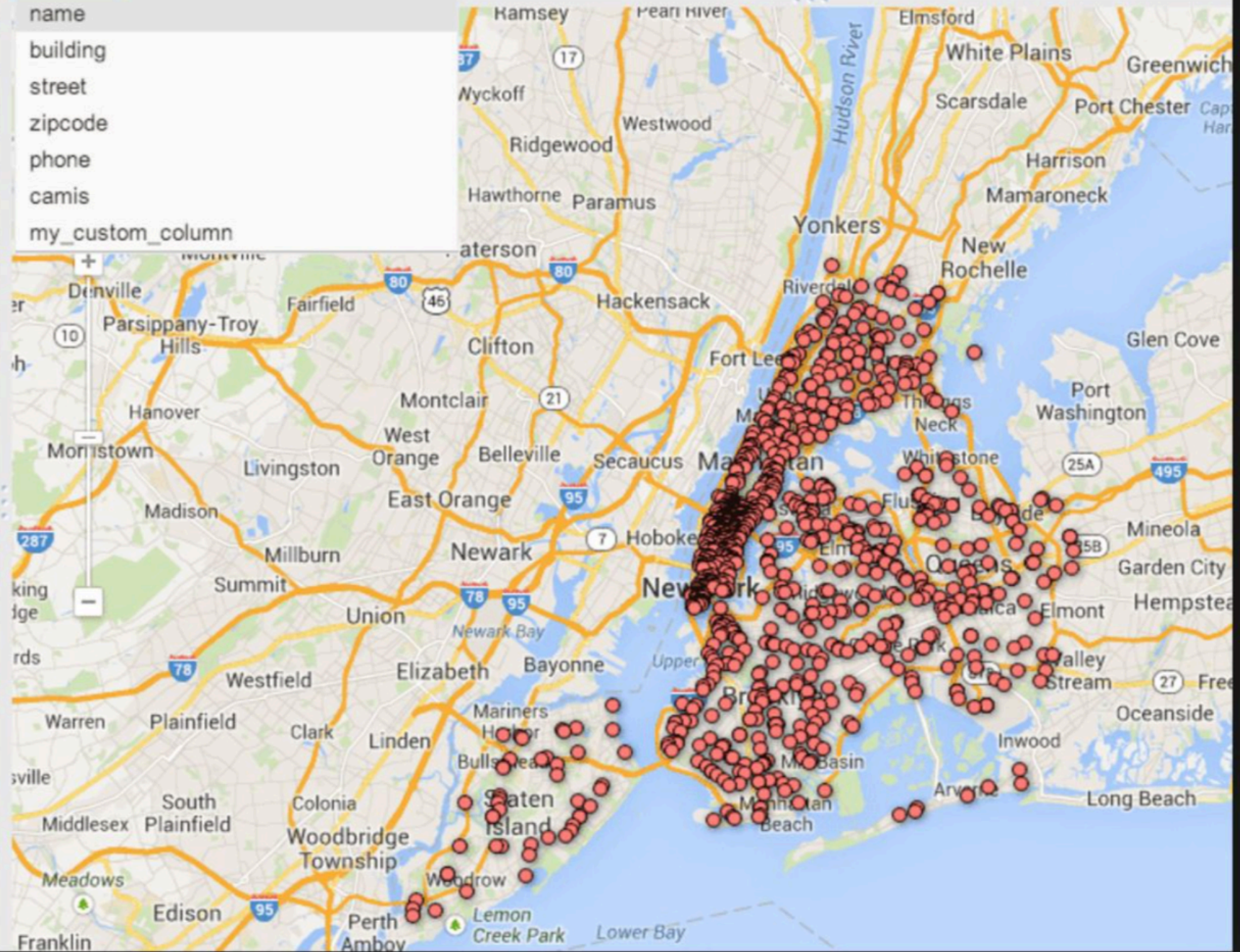
Create embeddable, updatable maps from a single spreadsheet or two or more tables that relate to each other
Point maps or choropleth maps (aka heat map) with customizable colors, markers, info windows

Basic FT easy to learn, larger curve to use developer tools

First: Can I map my data?

For a point map:

- Must have addresses, including city, state, zip
- Addresses need to be fairly clean and specific
- Even better if it includes exact latitude, longitude

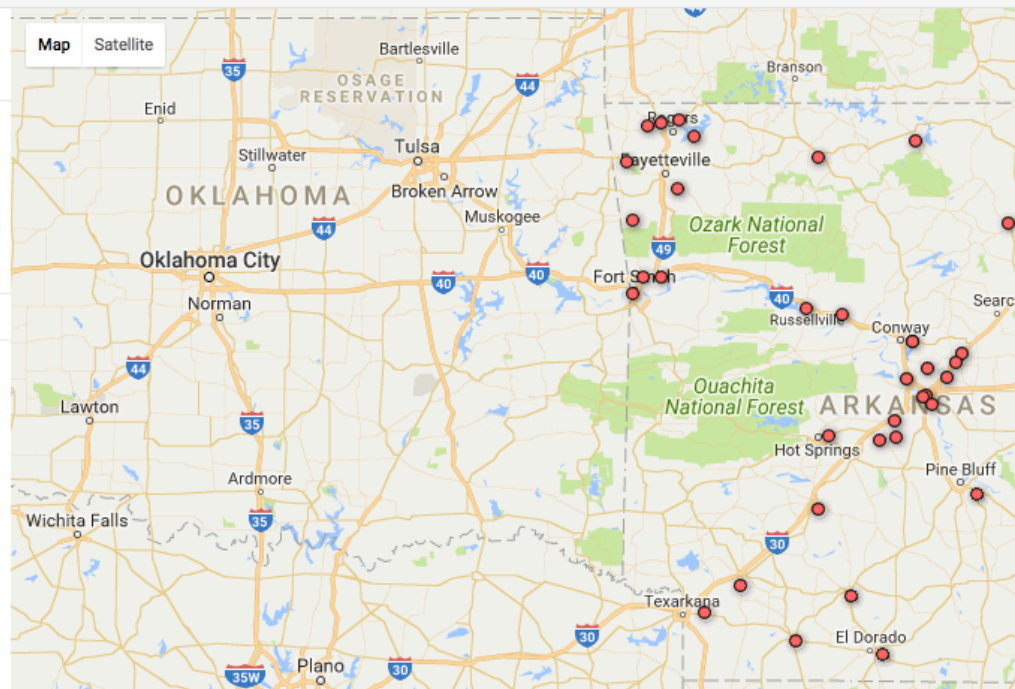
