

Hi Rob,

I found another solution that we could use. You can adjust the pixels size within the module.



Copy and paste max-height: 500px; and put it into the Main Element of the pictures. This causes the picture to fit to the box that it resides in. You may have a few pictures that pixel sizes - you can just keep adjusting until it looks right.

I went ahead and implemented the sizes. It looks better! Now I just have to fix the overlay color - it's wanting to go beyond the picture. What do you think?
