- Full payment is due upon enrollment. Email <u>cmslsns@uark.edu</u> for alternate arrangements.
- If additional lessons are added to a term, a new enrollment must be completed. A \$25 admin fee is charged for <u>each</u> registration form submitted.
- If you discontinue lessons at any point in the semester, email your instructor and CC <u>cmslsns@uark.edu</u>. You will be responsible for all lessons originally ordered unless we receive a written cancellation.

Lessons

- Students are expected to arrive at their lesson promptly and ready to begin.
- Students age 14 or younger must always be accompanied by a parent or teacher.
- Make up lessons will not be given if a student misses a lesson.
- Teachers will offer make up lessons for those missed due to teacher absence, university holidays, or inclement weather.
- If the Fayetteville School District is closed due to inclement weather, no in-person lessons will be taught. Students should contact teachers on those days.

In-person Lessons

- Parents must accompany children into the building and remain until the start of the lesson. Parents should pick up their children promptly after the lesson is finished.
- Parents are encouraged to be present during the lessons or sit outside the door.
- Community Music School lessons take place in the Billingsley Music Building or the Lewis E. Epley Jr. Band Building on the University of Arkansas Campus.

Virtual Lessons
