For my performance this December, I want to play with the conspiracy theory that the bird noises by the central plaza are recordings that are played from the palm trees. I like that this is relevant to students and I can add in things that fellow students will understand.

I got this idea because I was sitting outside at the amphitheater working and there were birds around me while I was thinking about the project. And then the song I was listening to also was singing about birds. Throughout all of this, I was thinking about how anything, an object, or whatever, can be a performance. I just decided to run with the idea of "birds" and see what I could make out of it.

Setup:

On stage is just an opaque, white screen. Little lighting necessary. Behind the screen is an actor. When the tree is projected, it is a white tree on a black background. The actor will be some color, maybe changing based on emotion, maybe just a single color based on aesthetic preference. I'm not sure yet.

Plot:

- 1. Person reading against palm tree
- 2. Bird noises start (low volume)
- 3. They stand, look up at the tree, and decide to investigate.
- 4. They start climbing the tree.





- 5. As they climb the tree, the volume of the bird noises gets higher (they are getting closer)
 - 6. They stop once and see a cat in the tree

- 7. They keep going and eventually get to the top, where they do find the speaker? Maybe. (the volume is the highest at this point)
- 8. They have a cool reaction to being able to find the speaker and prove the conspiracy theory true and then start to climb down (volume decreasing as they do)
- 9. They pass by the cat again
- When they reach the bottom, they take one last look at the tree, and walk away.
- 11. Then, a bird flies out of the tree.



What I imagine the technology will be:

- 1. A camera of some sort detecting the actor (depth? IR?)
- 2. Projection Mapping the Palm Tree animations
- 3. Projection of the Actor

Things I am still working out:

- 1. What happens at the climax? Is there a speaker? How is that revealed?
- 2. How is it established in the beginning the confusion of there being bird noises but no birds?
- 3. How long will the current plot take? Do I need more? Where would I expand?
- 4. Who will be the actor?
 - a. Once this idea is confirmed, I'll ask around and get an actor.
- 5. If I am projecting a white tree, would it be better just to have a black surface to project onto, rather than the white screen I was imagining? Is this feasible?
