Eligibility and Requirements

- All students* in any department or school in a humanities discipline or working on a humanities oriented urban research project in any discipline are eligible for fellowships.
(*Second semester seniors, however, are not eligible for Fall UUHRFs)
- Students must complete a **short application** describing their projects and methods. They must specify the form of the final project (research paper, documentary film, digital project, etc.). A breakdown of anticipated costs is requested as well.
- All standing faculty, adjunct, or clinical professors in humanistic disciplines or using humanities methods in all schools are eligible to serve as student mentors.
- Sponsoring faculty must write in support of student applications and specify how they will facilitate and mentor student research projects. Applicants must include this support letter in their application. As a condition of funding, students and sponsoring faculty must participate in the **final presentations** of projects by UUHRF fellows at the end of the academic year.
- All student projects must be completed and funds expended before graduation.
- Please note that these awards are taxable.

GRANTS (UP TO **\$1500 FOR STUDENTS & UP TO \$1500 FOR FACULTY MENTORS**) WILL BE AWARDED TO SUPPORT JOINT RESEARCH PROJECTS.
