## **Eligibility and Requirements**

FUND

All students\* in any department or school in a humanities discipline or working on a humanities oriented urban research project in any discipline are eligible for fellowships.

(\*Second semester seniors, however, are not eligible for Fall UUHRFs)

- Students must complete a short application describing their projects and methods. They must specify the form of the final project (research paper, documentary film, digital project, etc.). A breakdown of anticipated costs is requested as well.
- All standing faculty, adjunct, or clinical professors in humanistic disciplines or using humanities methods in all schools are eligible to serve as student mentors.
- Sponsoring faculty <u>must</u> write in support of student applications and specify how they will facilitate and mentor student research projects. Applicants must include this support letter in their application. As a condition of funding, students and sponsoring faculty must participate in the final presentations of projects by UUHRF fellows at the end of the academic year.
- All student projects must be completed and funds expended before graduation.
- <u>Please note that these awards are taxable.</u>

GRANTS (UP TO <u>\$1500 FOR STUDENTS</u> & UP TO <u>\$1500 FOR FACULTY MENTORS</u>) WILL BE AWARDED TO SUPPORT JOINT RESEARCH PROJECTS.
