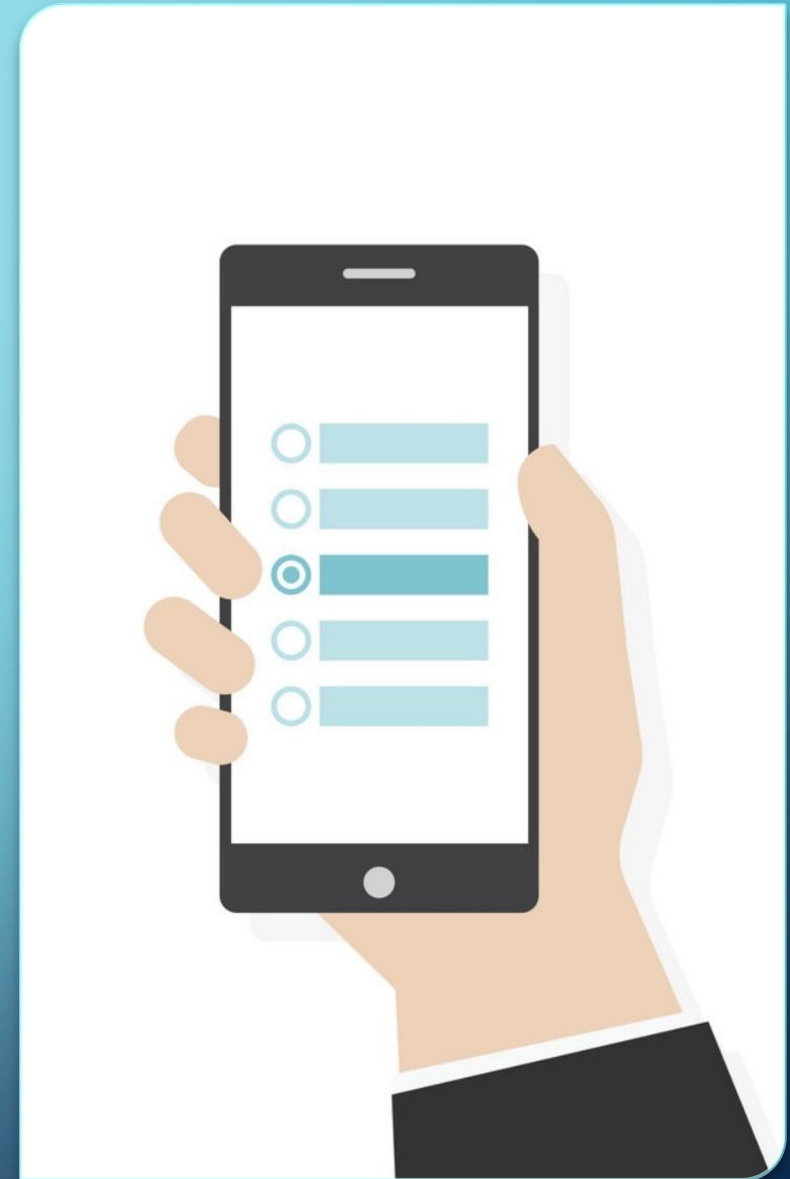

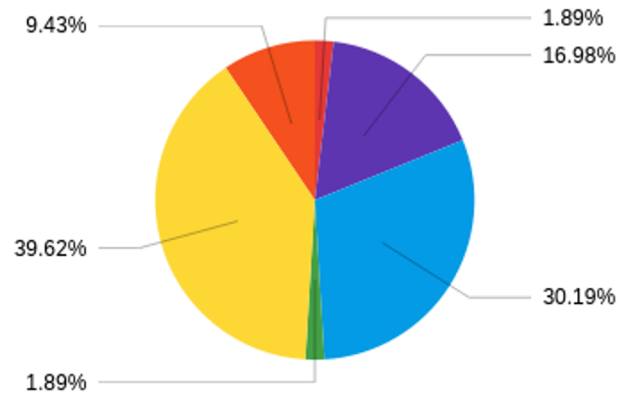
METHODS

- Analysis: Descriptive Statistics



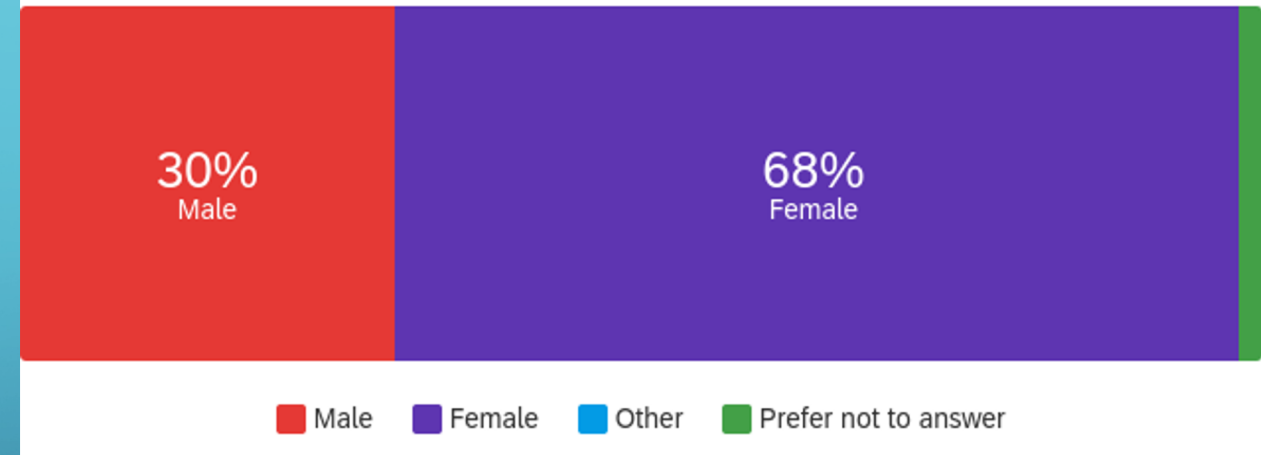

Gender Identity



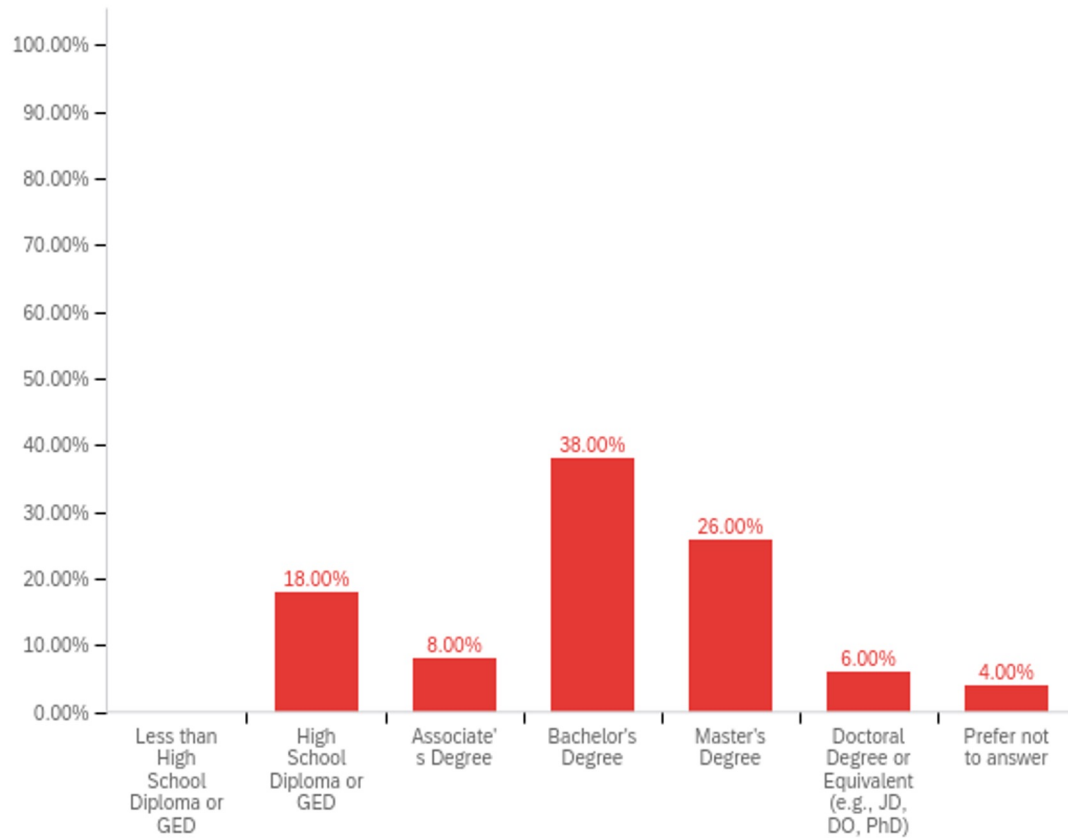

State of Residence

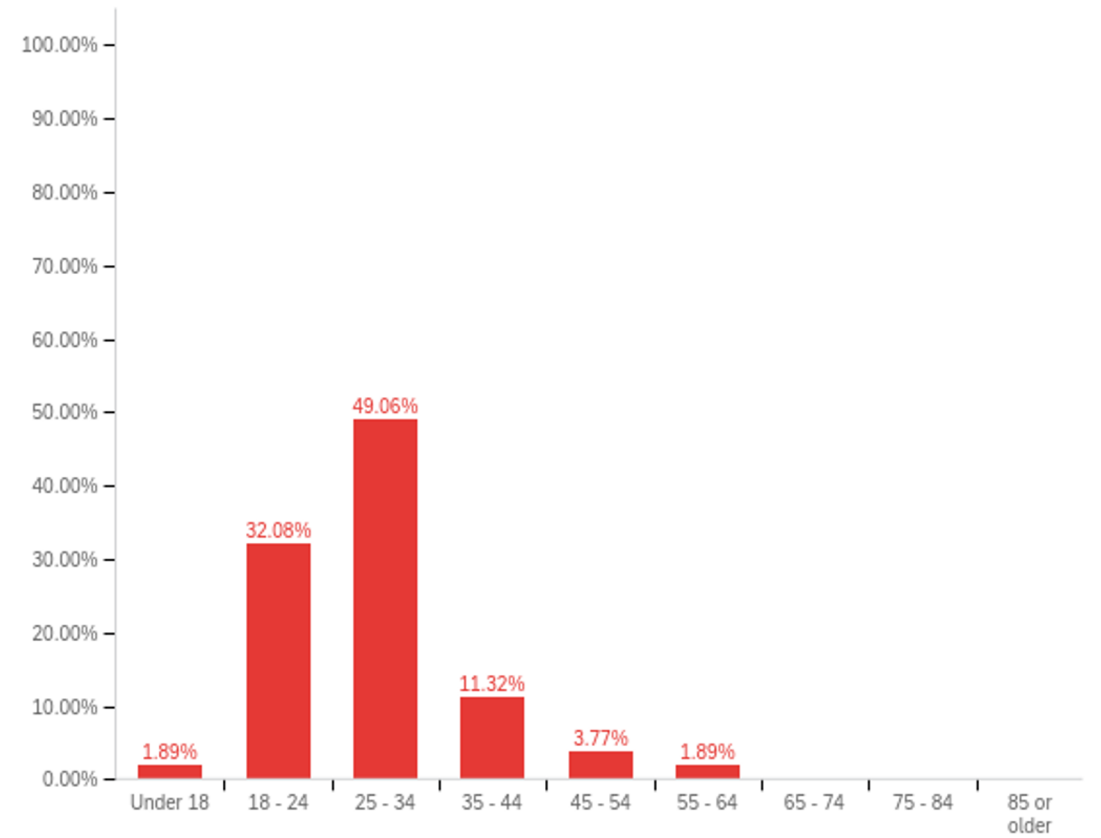

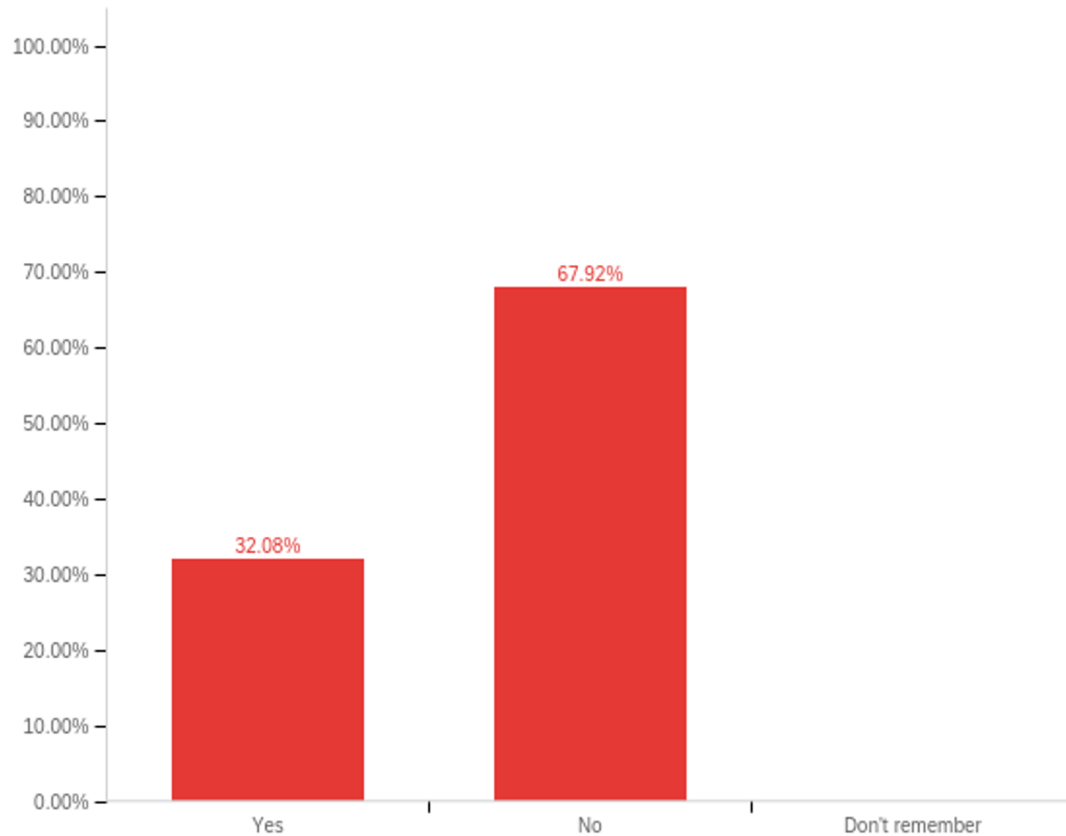

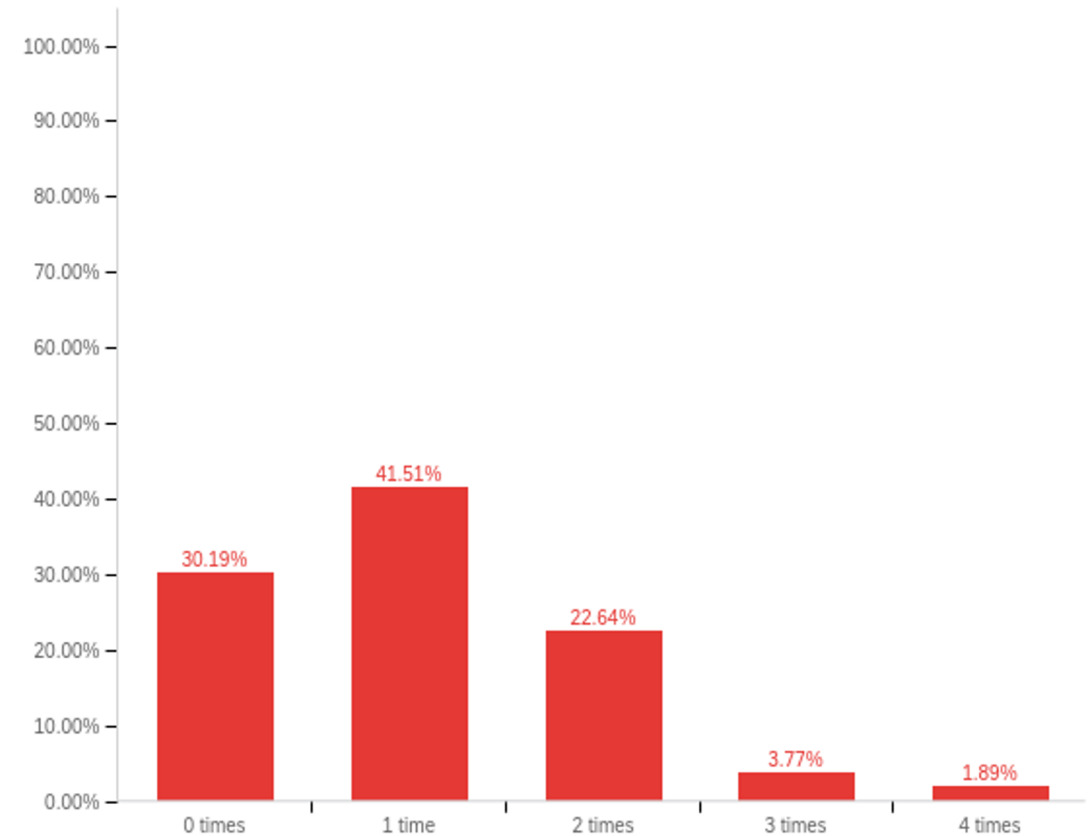

Has been told by Health Professional they had COVID-19

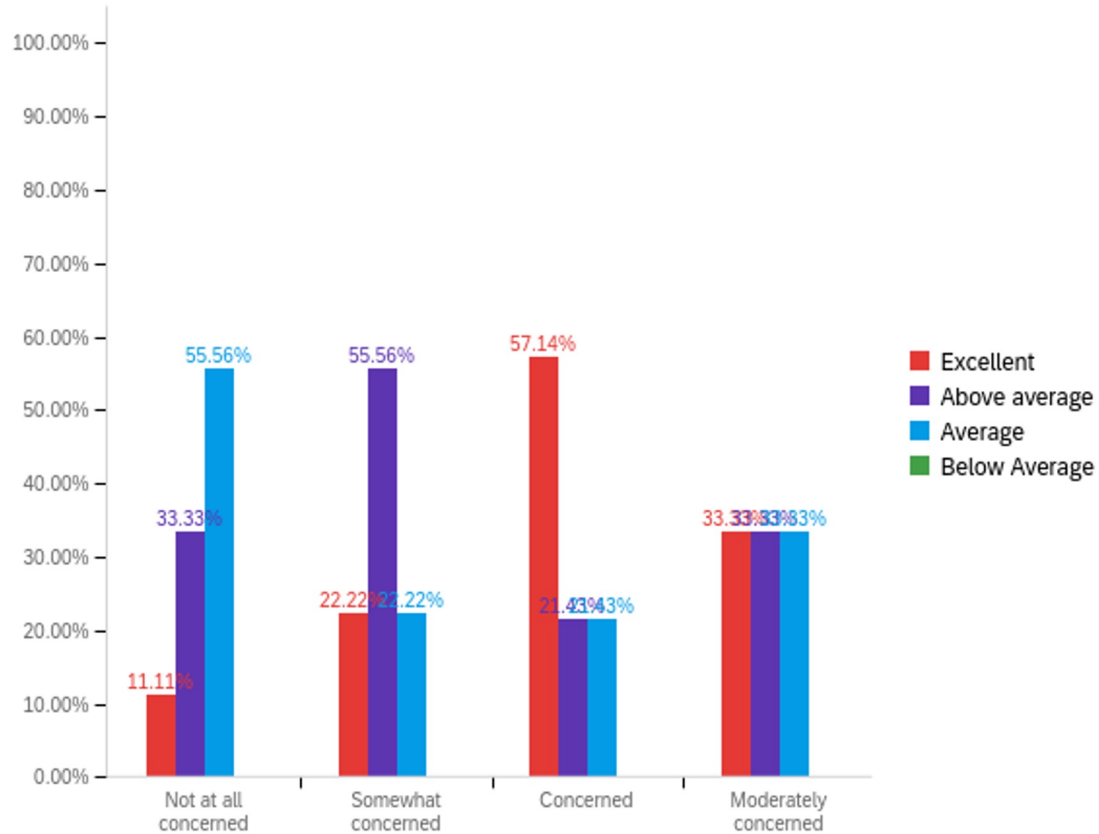


of times Participant thinks they had COVID-19

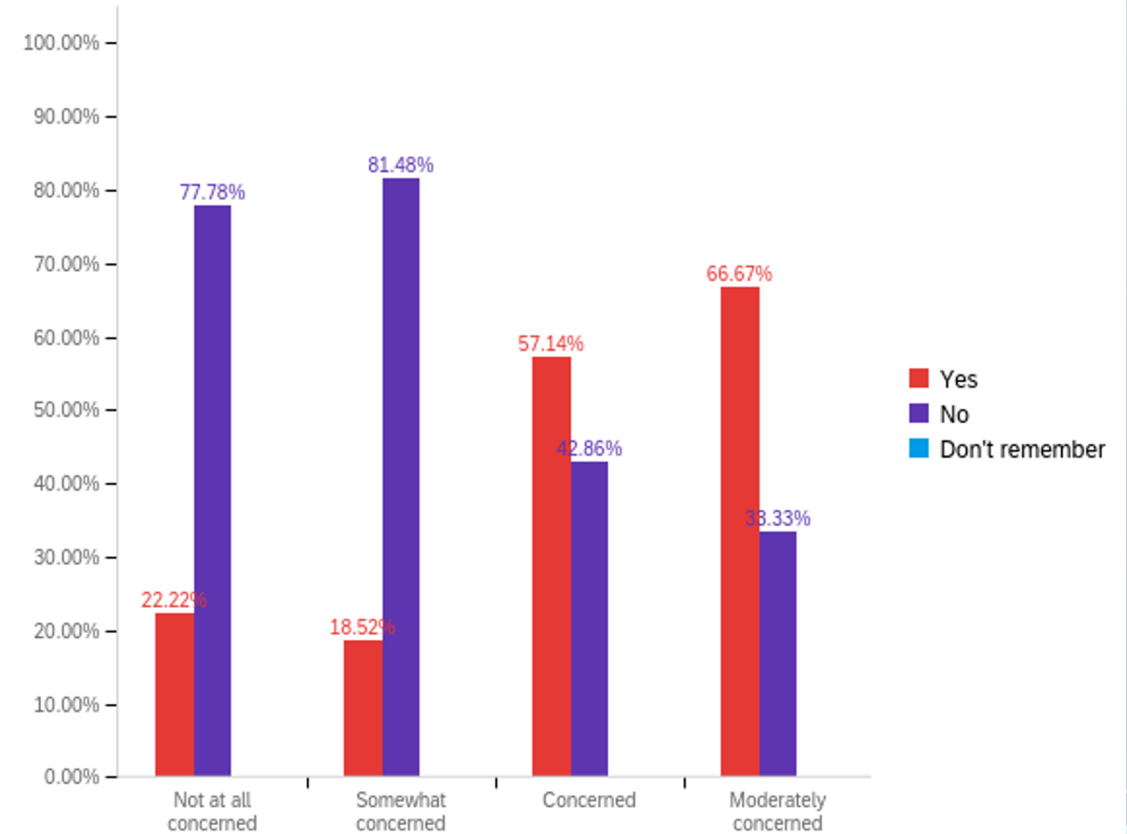

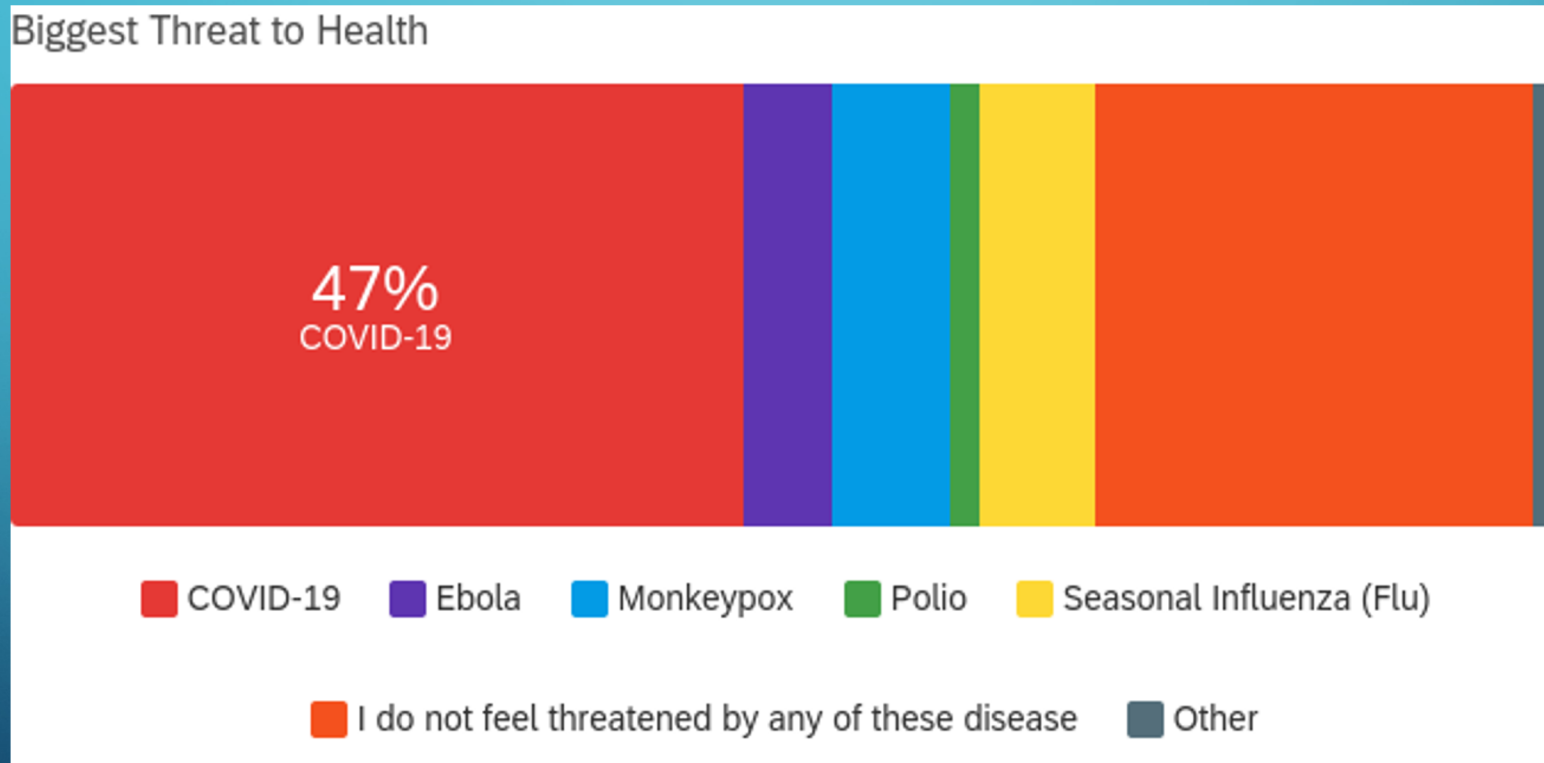
Concern/Self-Rated Compliance



Level of Concern/Personally Know Someone who was Hospitalized

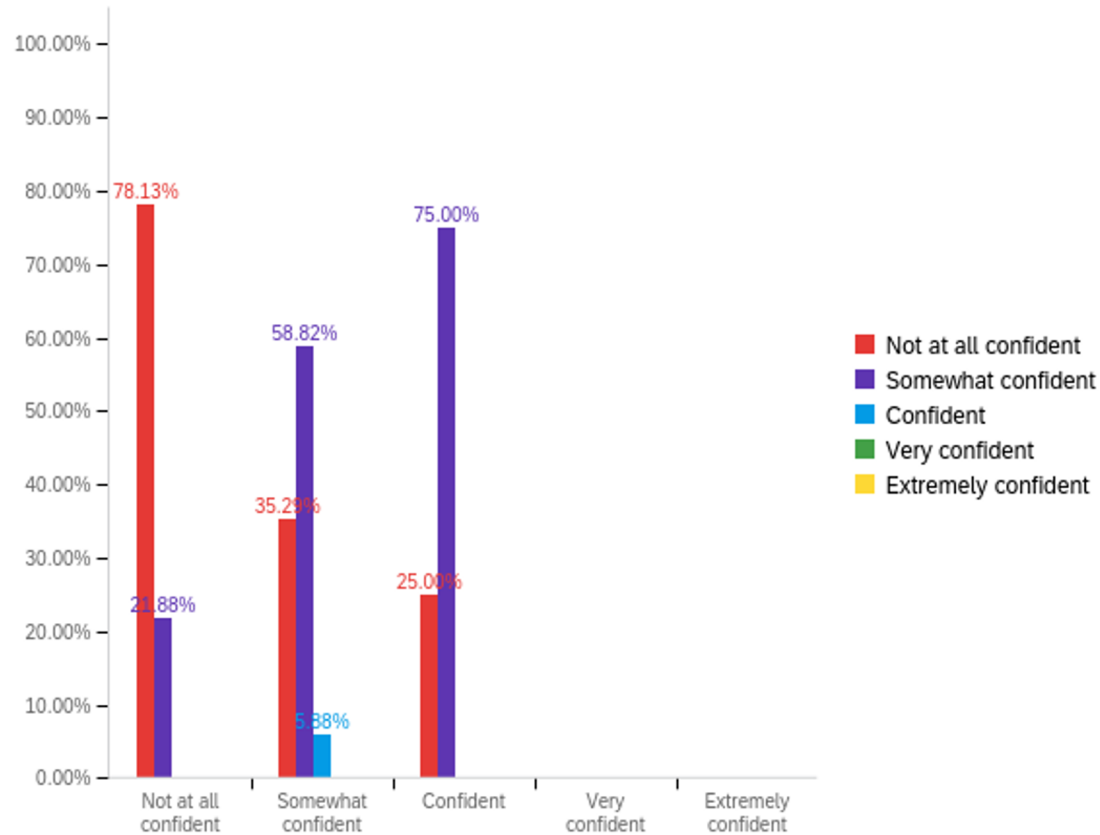

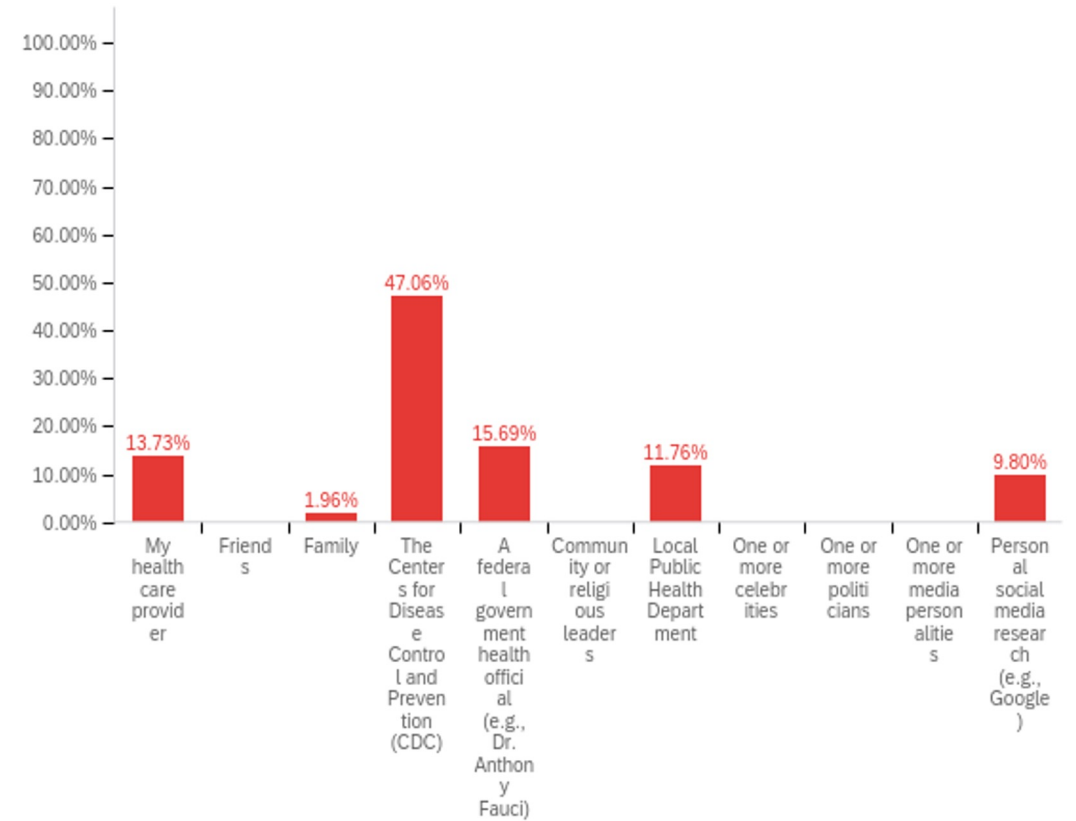
