ECOLOGICALLY GROWN COTTON

Ecologically grown cotton is grown using natural fertilisers and pesticides.

Using these natural farming methods is more respectful of water and local biodiversity, allowing farmers to grow cotton crops alongside other food crops such as oranges, tomatoes or turmeric.

Furthermore, plantations where ecologically grown cotton is grown avoid the use of genetically modified seeds, thus helping to preserve seed biodiversity and soil fertility.

We only use ecologically grown cotton certified by organisations which monitor the process from the raw material to the final product. At present, we work with:
